Trust Funds: More money than we thought

- o Teacher's assistant for 2 hours per day (\$18.50 per hr) @ 23 weeks left in school year
- \$2241 per aid = \$6696.36 4th grade
- \$2241 per aid = \$4482.24 1st grade
- o Propose \$11,482 from extra trust funds to hire this aid to help
- o 4th grade has more at risk kids than any other class in the school
- Spectrum kids GATE are also Special Ed with need for support (twice exceptional)

Demographics changing at the school

- More parents needing to work and less volunteering in the classroom
- Parent volunteers do not help with testing

• Follow up with Elections

- o Amendment B approved: more than just interest and dividends → earnings
- Bears Ears Monument → School Trust Lands
 - With Grand Staircase Utah lost a lot of land that generates funds
 - Bears Ears would confiscate even more land from Utah School Land Trust
 - PLI Plan swapping state land for federal land
 - Stay informed about the lands and advocate for strategies to keep our funds
