## HOMEWORK

This year we have chosen to not have nightly homework. Students will be given time in class to complete assignments. If they do not finish class assignments in the time given, it will then become homework to complete at home. We encourage students to read at least 20 minutes nightly. Students in Spectrum may need to work on large projects at home throughout the year. They may also need to do research at home. Please contact your child's teacher if you would like ways to help or challenge your child at home. We have online programs they can access at home to help with this.

## **Key Points**:

- Homework is different than assignments.
- Assignments are work that is assigned in class.
- If your child is not managing the time given in class to complete assignments, that work will then need to be taken home and finished.
- Each teacher may have ways of incentivizing/promoting reading in their classroom. Please refer to their class disclosure/policy.
- If your child is struggling academically, teachers may suggest/provide ways for them to get additional practice at home.
- If you want your child to do more at home, teachers will provide access information to digital tools.
- Classes may have projects throughout the year that require reading outside of class such as book reports, research, ancestor reports, etc. These projects may require parental support. Teachers will inform parents of these.
